

Freshman civics class are serving as a juvenile jury in the Harlan County Court, Jan. 31, 1957.

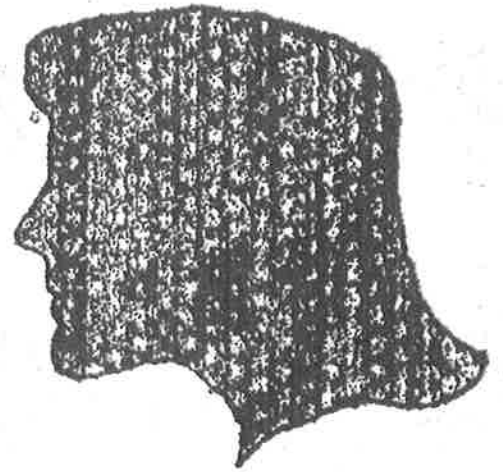
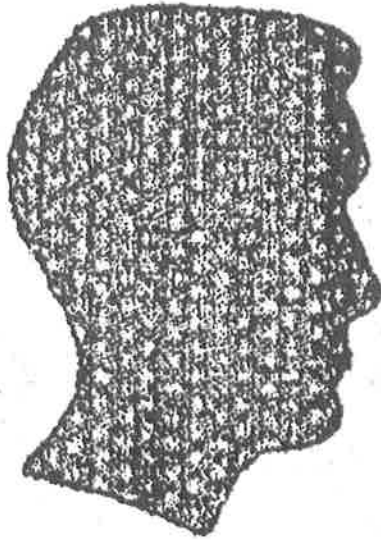
Basketball Queen

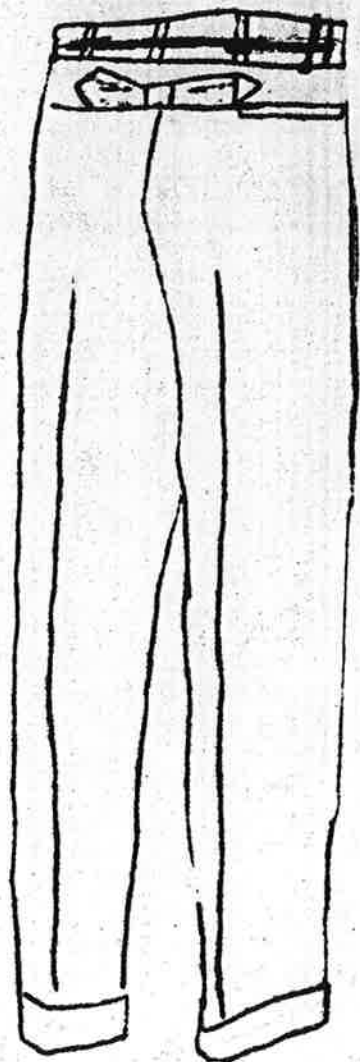
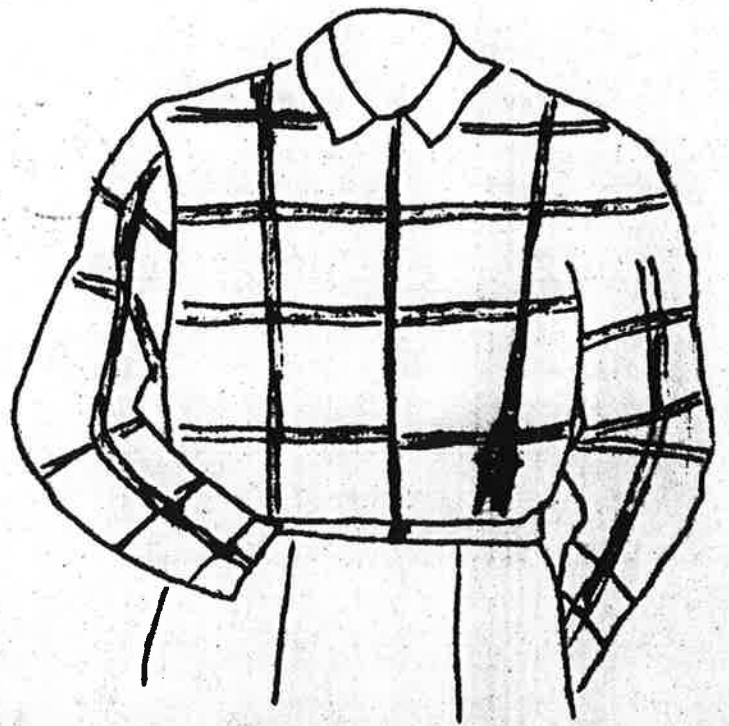
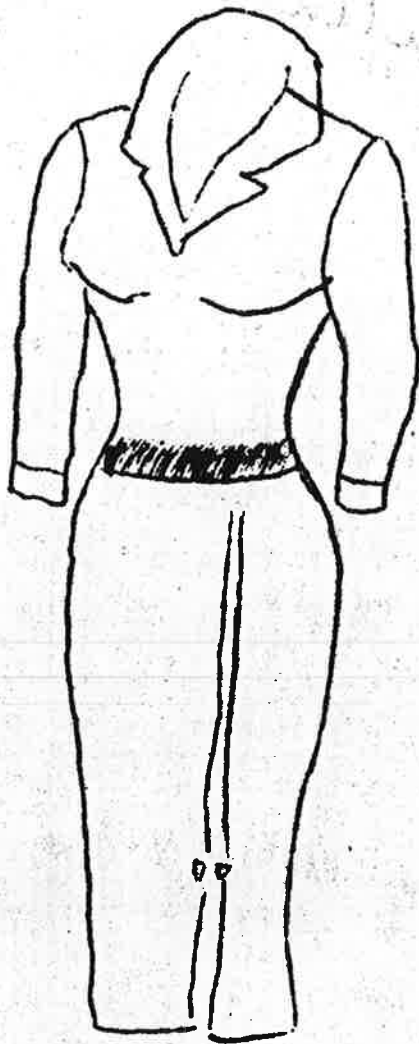
